The goal of our services are to improve the overall quality of life through symptom relief, improve daily functioning, self management, and emotional well being of those receiving services.

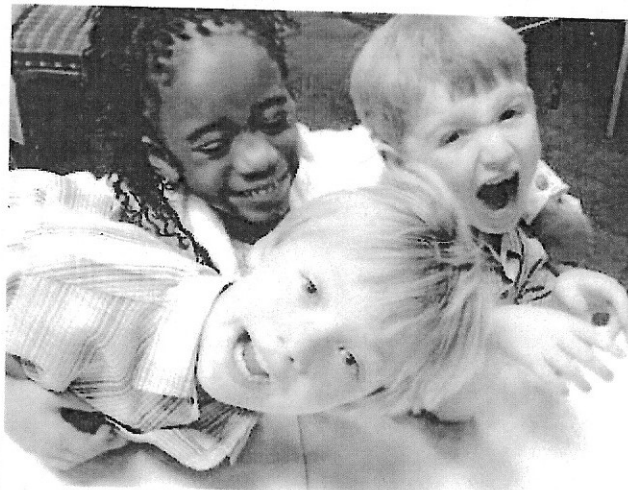


Cost Of Services

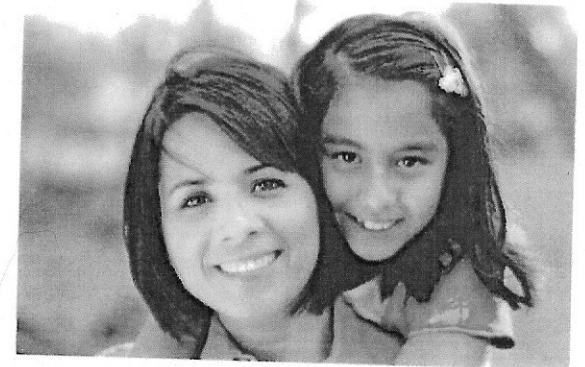
